To Whom It May Concern:

After being approached by militec to try out their product I was a bit sceptical about their claims on what the products was capable of. As I run a large workshop and the thought of using something I didn't know much about in customers cars was a bit concerning as I didn't know if it would cause any damage to the engines. So after thinking about it for while I plucked up the nerve to put militec into my engine which was not standard as I had carried out many modifications and was always very careful what kind of oil I was using let alone any additives.

After driving my car for around 500 miles I started to take readings to see how many miles the car was doing compared to previously but to be honest I didn't see much if any improvement in fuel economy the only thing I noticed around town driving was that the engine felt smoother and accelerated more freely which wasn't a bad thing at all on my engine as it was modified and previously it would run lumpy on idle.

I then carried a number of long trips to Birmingham which is were I was very surprised at the outcome, as before I would only get around 250 miles on a full tank of petrol I was getting 280 miles on  $\frac{3}{4}$  tank of petrol.

I then had the car retuned to make sure that the engine was running at the correct co levels, the engine needed slight adjustments due to the engine running smoother than before which enabled me to reduce the co readings further.

I then carried out one last trip to Birmingham driving around 70 miles per hour and found an even greater improvement in fuel economy; I was achieving now 320 miles on a full tank of petrol.

So after seeing for my self what militec was capable of I have now started to recommend it to customers as although I don't think all customers will benefit from immediate fuel economy they will see an improvement in drivability and in the long term see low cost repair bills as there will be less wear in the engine.
